




How have you decided to come to the Akdeniz University? 12 yanıt




Where did you find the necessary information to become an Erasmus student at Akdeniz University?




To what extent was this information useful to you? (1-5: 1=poor/negative, 5=excellent) 12 yant







Before coming to Antalya/Türkiye and Akdeniz University, had you got any kind of concern? 12 yanıt



How did your opinion change after coming to Akdeniz University, Antalya or Türkiye? 12 yanıt






What do you think about the course registration processes in Akdeniz University Student Affairs? (1-5: 1=poor/negative, 5=excellent)




Would you like to take Turkish language course?




Would you like to engage in any sports activity? (monthly activities such as: football tournament, volleyball tournament, tennis tournament etc.)








What are your thoughts about the Erasmus Team? (1-5: 1=poor/negative, 5=excellent)  $_{\rm 12\,yanit}$

## Please share your thoughts on your Erasmus mobility in general (pros and cons)
