## ACCESSIBLE UNIVERSITY AWARD TO AKDENIZ UNIVERSITY

Akdeniz University has been awarded the first prize in the category of "Accessible University" within the scope of the Turkey Accessibility Awards.
Rector of Akdeniz University Prof. Dr. Özlenen Özkan received the award from the First Lady Emine Erdoğan and the Minister of Family, Labour and Social Services Zehra Zümrüt Selçuk. Our Rector Prof. Dr. Özlenen Özkan stated "We are working to ensure an appropriate infrastructure of educational environment for our students with disabilities. This jury award encouraged us for new tasks in this scope."
Turkey Accessibility Awards were granted for scientific researches, successful projects, applications implemented, and services that contribute to the participation of persons with disabilities in social and economic life by the Ministry of Family, Labour and Social Services.


In cooperation with the International Relations Office and the Faculty of Education, four projects were implemented within the scope of Erasmus+ KA2 between the years of 2014 and 2021. In cooperation with the Disabled Students Unit Coordinator Asst. Prof. Dr. Emel Sardohan Yıldırım, the local activities of "Guide Us Into Arts - GUIA2!" Erasmus+ KA2 project, coordinated by EU Projects Coordinator Asst. Prof. Dr. Rabia Vezne, were held at Akdeniz University and these project activities for students with disabilities were also mentioned in the application form of the Accessibility Awards.
Since 2014, four Erasmus+ KA2 projects have been carried out for individuals with disabilities. These are; "Educational theatre as the place for raising inclusion and employability of people with disability", "Theatre Pitching for Employment" and "GUIA2!" projects. "Urban Survival Kits" Erasmus + KA2 project, funded in October 2020, will be carried out between 2021 and 2023 under the coordination of Northern Ireland and its target group is disabled individuals.

## ERASMUS CHARTER FOR HIGHER EDUCATION (ECHE) CERTIFICATE WAS SIGNED BY OUR RECTOR

The Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) for 2021-2027 Erasmus+ Programme period was signed by the Rector of Akdeniz University Prof. Dr. Özlenen Özkan.


The Vice-Rector for international relations Prof. Dr. Gülbin Arıcı, Head of the International Relations Office Prof. Dr. Olgun Kitapcı and Erasmus+ Institutional Coordinator H. Nuran Caner were also present during the signing ceremony.
Rector Prof. Dr. Özlenen Özkan said of the achievement; "We are proud that our application was accepted with 100 full points. As a member of the Erasmus+ family, we will continue our efforts to ensure that our students and staff benefit more from Erasmus+ programme with the approved and renewed ECHE. I wholeheartedly congratulate our friends who contributed to getting the ECHE with full points."


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## SUCCESS OF OUR COMPUTER ENGINEERING STUDENTS ON INTERNATIONAL PLATFORMS

The students of the Department of Computer Engineering of the Faculty of Engineering, where the medium of instruction is $100 \%$ English, continue to achieve great success on international platforms as a result of the education they received.


Alperen Aksoy, graduated from the Computer Engineering Master Programme in 2019, ranked the first in the field of "Network Technologies" of the Ministry of National Education's MEB YLSY scholarship exam held in 2019 and he was awarded a scholarship for a doctoral programme in Germany. He has started his doctoral studies in the Department of Computer Science at Friedrich-Alexander University of Erlangen-Nürnberg, which is one of the leading universities of Germany in the field of network technologies. Our graduate student stated that the three years he spent as a student and a staff member in the Department of Computer Engineering encouraged him to take steps at an international level and Alperen also emphasized that he benefited from the experience of the internationally experienced academic staff throughout his education.


A graduate student of the year of 2020, Gizem Ünlü was invited to and attended the Google I/O'19 event. She said of the event; "I/O is an event that Google has started to organize since 2008. This event, held once a year, lasts for three days and is a large scale event, where Google announces its new technologies, applications developed and updates. Google hosted its annual I/O conference at the Shoreline Amphitheatre, Mountain View in the USA with participation of more than 7.000 participants and it was opened with keynote presentation of Google's CEO Sundar Pichai and lasted with technical presentations. The year I attended, it focused on topics such as artificial intelligence, machine learning, augmented reality. On the last day of the event, I had the opportunity to visit Computer History Museum (CHM). In CHM, they grouped the changes in the technological world and the technologies developed by year and it was an amazing experience to see most of the things taught in our lectures. As a computer engineering student, I am very happy to have spent time there."

M. Fatih Baysan, graduated from the same department in 2020, stated that he has been aiming to study abroad since the first year he started to study at a bachelor's degree at Akdeniz University and added that he is delighted for having been accepted to the master programme of Technical University of Munich in Germany. He also stated that the fact that academic staff members of the Department of Computer Engineering have international experience was an advantage in education and job applications abroad.

We would like to congratulate our students for their international achievements and wish them success.

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## GREENER ERASMUS+ FOR A GREENER EARTH

In line with instructions of the European Commission, the digitalization process in Erasmus+ programme will start in all programme countries with the aim of a "Greener Erasmus". "Erasmus Without Paper (EWP)" will enable not only replacing the paper-based workflow by a digital one, but also reducing paper waste for environmentally friendly management of Erasmus+ data. The new Erasmus+ programme 2021-2027 will be more digital and greener.

An online meeting focused entirely on Erasmus Without Paper (EWP) was held on 18 January 2021, hosted by the Ankara University EU Office.

As a result of our diligent work, our university has been the fourth university to be integrated into the EWP system among 195 universities in Turkey.

## \#OURCOMMONFUTURE DIGITAL COMMUNICATION CAMPAIGN

Under the coordination of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs - Directorate for EU Affairs, the digital communication campaign was carried out on social media under the hashtag \#OurCommonFuture between the dates of 22 - 26 February 2021. With the participation of the beneficiary institutions of the EU projects, \#OurCommonFuture digital campaign aimed at increasing awareness about the results and benefits of the projects implemented under Turkey and EU cooperation.


Akdeniz University participated in the digital campaign with seven ongoing Erasmus+ KA2 projects by sharing project benefits on our social media accounts.

## THE LOGO DESIGN CONTEST OF THE "DIVE" ERASMUS+ KA2 PROJECT

A logo design contest was organized within the scope of "Digital Internationalisation in Vocational Education (DIVE)" Erasmus+ KA2 Digital Education Readiness Strategic Partnership Project (KA226), coordinated by Norwegian University of Science and Technology in partnership with Akdeniz University.

## THE TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETINGS OF "VARTES" ERASMUS+ KA2 STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP PROJECT

Within the scope of the "Virtual \& Augmented Reality Toolkit to Engage Seniors Brain With InterGenerational Understanding (VARTES)" Erasmus+ KA2 Adult Education Strategic Partnership project, coordinated by STUCOM from Spain in partnership with Akdeniz University, four transnational project meetings were held online regarding the COVID-19 process and project activities. Online transnational project meetings were held on the dates of 19 November 2020, 8 January 2021, 19 January 2021, 11 February 2021 and 12 March 2021. Project coordinators from five project partner institutions attended the meetings and worked on the intellectual outputs of the project. Project coordinator Asst. Prof. Dr. Rabia Vezne attended the meetings in order to represent Akdeniz University.


## ONLINE AUGMENTED REALITY (AR) TRAINING OF THE "VARTES" PROJECT

Within the scope of the VARTES project, Augmented Reality Materials Preparation Training was held on 25 March 2021. Prof. Dr. Zeynep Özer, Asst. Prof. Dr. Leyla Muslu and Asst. Prof. Dr. Rabia Vezne, the project team of Akdeniz University, attended the training on the use of Zapworks application and AR code generation. After the training, AR code will be produced for household goods and electric vehicles in order to warn the elderly against the risks at home, and a case study will be carried out.


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## THE ONLINE TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING OF "MATT" ERASMUS+ KA2 STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP PROJECT

Within the scope of the "Mapping Teacher Education in Europe (MATT)" Erasmus+ KA2 Higher Education Strategic Partnership Project, coordinated by Akdeniz University, a transnational project meeting was held online focusing on the COVID-19 process and project activities on 22 January 2021. Coordinators of the six project partner institutions attended the meeting and worked on the mapping activity of native language teacher education in Europe.


## ONLINE TRAINING OF THE "MATT" PROJECT

Within the scope of the MATT project, two online trainings were held on the dates of 4 March 2021 and 17 March 2021. Staff from six project partner institutions attended the trainings. The admission procedures to Native Language Teaching (NLT) Department, course contents and teaching practice implementations in 25 European countries were presented by partner organizations. Especially the similarities and differences in NLT education in 25 countries were emphasized in the training.

Within the scope of the IAESTE internship programme, the Foreign Language Exam for the 2020-2021 academic year was held on 21 December 2020. As a result of the Foreign Language Exam, 25 students were qualified as candidate students to benefit from the IAESTE.
