The course emphasizes major concepts of learning theory and covers relevant motivational and developmental theories. The course underlines the relationship between theory, research and practice. Major objectives of the course: 1. To inform students with the general concepts of learning theory; 2. To review, understand, and critique research related to theories of learning; 3. To provide students the opportunity to engage in critical analysis of theories ; 4.
