10	PhD in gerontology	GER 7012		Aging and Being	Fall	This course examines the contributions of phenomenology and existentialism to understanding the phenomenon of ageing. The fundamental texts of philosophers such as Bergson, Husserl, Heidegger, Sartre, Levinas, and Derrida are critically read and discussed. Concepts including existence, time, selfhood, subjectivity, ethics, meaning, and lived experience are evaluated within the context of ageing. In addition, the ideas of Thomas Hobbes, John Locke, Jeremy Bentham, William James, and John Dewey are analysed from the perspectives of ageing, later-life experiences, and gerontology within the pragmatist tradition. The course aims to develop students' ability to interpret philosophical texts, evaluate ageing from different theoretical perspectives, and relate these perspectives to contemporary debates in gerontology.
