

Erasmus+ Exchange Programme

Erasmus+ Programme is the programme that covers grant support in the field of education, youth and sports of the European Union. Within the scope of the programme, individuals are offered the opportunity to take part in youth activities based on education, training, internship, professional development and non-formal learning abroad. In addition, collaborations between institutions are supported through partnership activities. European Solidarity Programme (European Solidarity Corps, ESC); is a new European Union initiative that aims to meet social needs, creating opportunities for young people to volunteer, work or network on projects that benefit society in their own country or abroad, while promoting their personal, educational, social, civil and professional development.

Akdeniz University is among the pilot universities that started the programme in 2003.

The Erasmus+ Programme is conducted by International Relations Office at Akdeniz University. Akdeniz University carries out KA131 and KA171 projects under the terms of KA1 projects and organize the KA2 projects including Partnerships for Cooperation and Erasmus Mundus...etc.

Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) application for the 2021-2027 period has been accepted with 100 points.

Under the Free Mover Programme, students studying at associate degree, undergraduate, master's or doctoral degree level at a foreign university can study at Akdeniz University as a guest student for one semester or one academic year after paying a term or annual fee to both their own university and the host university. Students who want to study at a foreign university under the Free Mover Programme need to contact the university they wish to attend for information about the programme and the necessary documentation. Participating students are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses and for all fees payable to Akdeniz University and to the university where they will study.
