| 4 | English Language and Literature <i>İngiliz Dili ve Edebiyatı</i> | İDE 7036 | 10 | Utopia and Distopia | Spring <i>Bahar</i> | In this course, primarily the origins and development of utopian and dystopian literature are studied with reference to its place in English literature, in different cultures, eras, and literatures as well; representative texts are analysed comparatively within the context of the major principles of utopian and distopian thought. Through this comparative study, interdisciplinary examples as well as literary examples will be studied in order to comprehend how the concepts of utopia and dystopia are situated in today's life. | Assit.
