The course deals with the downside of economic globalization such as the underlying reasons for crises and their effects on the economy, poverty and environmental degradation. 3. The course examines the actors in the world economy: international organizations, multinational corporations and regional integration initiatives etc. In addition the development of the global economic governance system is discussed.
