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The work and operations of international exchange and internship programs such as Erasmus+, Free Mover and IAESTE continue uninterrupted. We are doing the background studies of suspended programs such as Farabi and Mevlana as if the programs in question will be opened tomorrow. We are trying to fulfill the duties of our Office in the admission of our international students to our University and in the promotion of our University abroad. We try to act in accordance with the principles of the European Youth Year 2022 in all our business and transactions. We are trying to pave the way for many of our students to benefit from international opportunities by promoting EU projects that are not managed by us, as well as international scholarship and internship programs such as Jean Monnet and Fulbright, as well as programs whose execution is left entirely to our Office. To date, we have accomplished a great deal with a small number of staff. All these activities require serious effort. The secret of this success lies in the team spirit of all our staff. I sincerely congratulate our staff who received the Certificate of Appreciation and thank all our staff for their devoted work." said.

I've started to send e-mails to different universities around Türkiye to be part of Erasmus offices as a social media worker. At the end, my choice



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
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was Akdeniz University because of the huge network it has.
