MESSAGE FROM THE EDITOR



Greetings from the 48th issue of the Newsletter of the International Relations Office (IRO).

I would like to begin my remarks with encouraging news that clearly demonstrates the growing scientific productivity and international visibility of Akdeniz University under the leadership of our Rector, Prof. Dr. Özlenen Özkan. The 2025 list of "The World's Most Influential Scientists", prepared through a collaboration between Elsevier and Stanford University, has been officially published. In the list, which is released annually under the categories of "Career-Long Impact" and "Single-Year Impact", a total of 23 scientists from our University were ranked among the most distinguished researchers worldwide. Specifically, 18 academics from Akdeniz University were included in the Career-Long Impact category, while another 18 were recognized in the Single-Year Impact category, reflecting their outstanding scholarly performance. This remarkable achievement stands as strong evidence that our internationalization efforts are yielding significant results on a global scale. The success of our esteemed academics fills us with great pride; I extend my heartfelt congratulations to them and wish them continued success.

We have also received promising news regarding our project applications under the EU Erasmus+ Programme. Within the scope of the Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility action (KA171 Project), our University has been awarded approximately 55,000 euro in funding by the Turkish National Agency to carry out student and staff mobility activities with universities in 11 non-EU countries. In addition, under the Erasmus+ Programme Key Action 2 – Partnerships for Cooperation, specifically within the KA220 Cooperation Partnerships, our University has been granted funding for a total of three projects in the 2025 call, including one project coordinated by our institution and two in which we participate as a partner. We would like to express our sincere gratitude to all those who contributed to these achievements, especially our Rector, Prof. Dr. Özlenen Özkan.

In this issue, we also present information on the newly signed agreements within the scope of the Erasmus+ Programme, as well as details regarding incoming and outgoing students and visitors from higher education institutions across various regions of the world. 23 ACADEMICIANS FROM AKDENİZ UNIVERSITY INCLUDED in the WORLD'S MOST INFLUENTIAL SCIENTISTS LIST

The 2025 edition of "The World's Most Influential Scientists" list, prepared through a collaboration between Elsevier and Stanford University, has been published. The list, which is released annually under the "Career-Long Impact" and "Single-Year Impact" categories, evaluated more than 200,000 scientists worldwide across 22 main fields and 174 subfields. Among researchers with a minimum of five publications, those ranked within the top 100,000 according to the c-score metric or those placed in the top 2% of their respective subfields were included in the list.

Within the scope of the "Career-Long Impact" and "Single-Year Impact" categories, which take into account indicators such as citation counts, h-index, hm-index, c-score, and author-position-adjusted citations, a total of 23 scientists from Akdeniz University were included among the world's most influential researchers. In this context, academicians from Akdeniz University were listed in the Career-Long Impact category, while 18 academics were also recognized in the Single-Year Impact category for their effective scholarly performance.

We congratulate our distinguished academicians and wish them continued success in their academic endeavors.



PROJECTS AWARDED GRANTS UNDER THE KA220 COOPERATION PARTNERSHIPS 2025 CALL

Under the Erasmus+ Programme Key Action 2: Partnerships for Cooperation, the 2025 call for proposals within the KA220 Cooperation Partnerships has been concluded. Our University has been awarded funding for a total of three projects, including one as coordinator and two as partner institutions.

The project titled "European Digital Network and Virtual Centre for Empowering Families with Intellectual Disability Children", coordinated by Prof. Dr. İlkay Boz from the Faculty of Nursing, will be implemented under the coordination of Akdeniz University. The project will run for two years with a total budget of €250,000.

The project titled "Development of an Informal Care Ecosystem Empowered by Digital and Green Skills", in which Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mustafa Çoban from the Faculty of Health Sciences participates as a project partner, has been awarded a grant by the German National Agency. The project has a total budget of €400,000, of which €64,520 has been allocated to our University.


