Emel Kahraman, Serhan Karaloğlu and Elif Önal. Virtual Fair Representatives promoted our university internationally with online interviews between 08.00 - 20.00 for three days by instant messaging to prospective students and presenting information to students about the departments/programmes of our university, admission criteria for international students, exchange programmes.





AKDENIZ UNIVERSITY IS RANKED AMONG THE BEST UNIVERSITIES IN THE WORLD

Akdeniz University was among the best universities in the world in the ranking announced by the Academic Rating Organization Shanghai Ranking. In the field-based ranking, Akdeniz University was among the best universities in the world in the fields of Hospitality & Tourism Management and Nursing.

The Global Ranking of Academic Subjects (GRAS) 2022, which represents the most comprehensive and objective ranking of world universities by subject, has been announced by ShanghaiRanking Consultancy. In the worldwide ranking, 5000 universities from 96 countries were evaluated in 54 subjects in the fields of natural sciences, engineering, life sciences, medical sciences and social sciences. According to the 2022 GRAS list, Akdeniz University was among the best universities in the world in the field of Hospitality & Tourism Management, in the 151-200 band, and in the Nursing field, it managed to enter the list in the 201-300 band.

The performance of universities in related subjects in the ranking; International academic awards were evaluated on a set of objective academic indicators and data, including best academic achievements, research quality and international collaboration. While Akdeniz University is one of the four universities from Turkey to enter the list of the best universities in the world in the field of Hospitality & Tourism Management, it has proven its success worldwide as one of the three universities in the field of Nursing.


