

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS OFFICE

The International Relations Office (IRO) was established for the purpose of making the best contribution to the internationalization strategy of Akdeniz University, enabling the effective and sustainable implementation of our internationalization strategies in a way which takes into account the new conditions which have been introduced into the higher education system in the field of internationalization. The IRO is responsible for the Erasmus+ Programme, the Bologna Process, the Mevlana and Farabi Exchange Programmes, the Free Mover Programme and the IAESTE Programme, as well as international cooperation activities with universities abroad and the coordination of international students, and the international activities of the university.

STUDENT EXCHANGE OPPORTUNITIES AT AKDENIZ UNIVERSITY

Akdeniz University regards internationalization as one of its highest priorities, and as a result of this view places international students and exchange students at the centre of its internationalization strategy. If a student would like to study at Akdeniz University as an exchange student for one or two semesters, Akdeniz University provides a wide range of options.

If a student wants to apply to study as part of the Erasmus+ Programme or the Mevlana Exchange Programme, or to take part in a student exchange under the terms of Akdeniz University's cooperation protocols, then there needs to be an Erasmus+ bilateral agreement, a Mevlana Exchange Programme protocol or a cooperation protocol between student's home university and Akdeniz University. If there is no bilateral agreement in place between student's home university and Akdeniz University, student can also apply to the Free Mover Programme, for which no bilateral agreement is needed.



ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

Akdeniz University, which was among one of the 15 Turkish universities, participated the Erasmus Programme as a pilot university in 2003. Akdeniz University progressed to the point where its work was recognised by the European Commission and awarded the Erasmus Bronze Award – Creativity and Innovation in 2009. It was the first time that a Turkish university had been recognised with an award of this kind.

Akdeniz University has an Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) 2014-2020, and has an active role in the Erasmus + Programme, sending and hosting students and staff to Erasmus+ programme countries. Akdeniz University has established 254 Erasmus+ agreements with 28 programme countries.

MEVLANA EXCHANGE PROGRAMMI

Mevlana Exchange Programme, which was initiated by the Council of Higher Education in 2013, aims the exchange of students and academic staff between the Turkish higher education institutions and higher education institutions of other countries. Mevlana Exchange Programme scholarships are provided by the Council of Higher Education in Turkey. Akdeniz University has 97 Mevlana Exchange Programme protocols from 29 countries.

FREE MOVER PROGRAMME

Free Mover Programme is a programme which students who are engaged in education at the undergraduate degree or graduate degree level at a university abroad can study at another university for one term or one academic year as a guest student by paying a term or annual fee to the host university. Within the scope of the Free Mover Programme, students from non-partner universities have the opportunity to study at Akdeniz University.

FARABI EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Farabi Exchange Programme was initiated by the Council of Higher Education in 2009 as a national exchange programme for Turkish universities. The programme aims to enable student exchanges between higher education institutions in Turkey. APPLICATION PROCESS FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Akdeniz University has 2,400 international students, studying in both undergraduate and graduate programmes. International students who would like to study an associate degree or a bachelor's degree can be eligible to study at Akdeniz University provided that they achieve a pass grade in the Akdeniz University International Student Examination (AKDENİZ YÖS). AKDENİZ YÖS-2019 will be held on 4 May 2019 at 48 centres in 28 countries. International student candidates will be able to apply for the AKDENİZ YÖS-2019 between the dates of 14 January - 9 April 2019 using the online application system at the following location; yos.akdeniz.edu.tr.
