Within the context of this meeting, training was evaluated, methods used in preparation of handbooks were determined and also questions and problems related to project management and implementation were discussed.









#### "Short- Period Training" organized in Germany

Within the scope of the Project entitled "Open Hearts And Welcoming Communities For Immigrants And Refugees", granted under the framework of Erasmus+ Program Strategic Partnership Adult Education Projects, "Short-Period Training" was organized for 17 participants from 8-12 May 2017 in BEdCon GmbH\* in Berlin, Germany. During the training Programme, participants were informed about the ongoing Project "Women 4 Women..." by Charité Berlin, and they were introduced with formal practices regarding health, legal and cultural adaptation issues, structured exclusively for immigrants and refugees. Moreover, they visited experienced institutions which work closely with refugees and immigrants in Germany.

Project coordinator Prof. Dr. Beykan Çizel's statement regarding this training was as follows: "We believe that this training will be of great benefit towards fulfilling the main goal of our project which targets immigrants and refugees' issues that may raise in their temporary residing countries in terms of unemployment, housing, food, and language, by drawing out road maps and facilitating communication and intercultural understanding with the local residents. The knowledge and experience gained in Germany will be of significant importance in the process of preparing the output of our project."
