At Akdeniz University, the management of financial resources, which falls under the scope of special budget institutions within the Central Government Budget, is structured annually. This process involves allocating the appropriations provided by the budget law to various spending units. The distribution takes into account the previous years' expenditures and the projected expenditures for the upcoming year, based on available budgetary resources.

The investment projects funded by our university's capital grants focus on areas such as education, health, sports, culture, and technology, with a particular emphasis on environmental investments that promote sustainable energy sources and reduce fossil fuel consumption. A notable example of these investments is the installation of solar energy systems. Once completed, this project will contribute to reducing fossil fuel consumption and related emissions, lowering the carbon footprint, and fostering a sustainable economy and environment across the university.
